INTERNET AUTHORIZATION FOR STUDENT USE
-SUMMARY-

Purpose of Internet Use: The Internet will serve as a supplement to classroom instruction. It will give immediate access to current information that is being studied. It will build skills in preparation for future learning.

Guidelines for Internet Use: Students will be supervised at all times. Internet rules will be enforced and any misuse will be reported to the building principal. Any misuse may result in loss of Internet privileges. Parents will be notified of such action.

Safeguards for Internet Use: Students will have access to pre-approved sites. All activity can and will be monitored at all times through a central location within the District.

Student Rules for Internet Use (As posted in each lab):

- 1. The Internet is to be used for EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES ONLY.
2. Do not print or download anything from the Internet without your teacher's permission.
3. If inappropriate material appears on the screen, immediately turn off your monitor and raise your hand for your teacher's help.

Misuse or failure to follow the rules WILL result in loss of Internet privileges, and your principal will be notified.
